- Dual Language is a form of education in which students are taught literacy, Science and Math content in two languages. In Seminole County, the two languages are English and Spanish.
- Dual Language education is an effective approach to developing language proficiency and literacy in English and Spanish. The program develops student proficiency in four domains: listening, speaking, reading, and writing in both languages.
