POSITION GOAL

To develop and implement various safety plans and inspections for the district to help ensure that the district educational and support facilities are maintained in compliance with applicable codes and regulations.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. *Perform Comprehensive Safety Inspections including fire, sanitation, and casualty on all District educational and support facilities in accordance with State Requirements for Educational Facilities.
- 2. *Develop and implement plans to correct any discrepancies identified during the comprehensive safety inspections.
- 3. *Coordinate inspections performed by other governmental agencies such as the local Fire Marshals, Florida Division of Safety, Florida Department of Education, and SCPS inspectors.
- 4. *Coordinate the activities of all other inspectors.
- 5. *Develop inspection schedules for all school district sites.
- 6. *Prepare the annual fire safety report for the Florida State Fire Marshal.
- 7. *Develop written safety plans and programs as required by the Florida Division of Safety, OSHA, and/or the School Board of Seminole County.
- 8. *Provide safety-related information and consultation to district management.

- 9. *Maintain appropriate records and files pertaining to inspections, corrections, training, and other safety-related issues.
- 10. Perform other duties as assigned by the Director of Facilities Services.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Light Work

Exerting up to 20 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 10 pounds of force frequently. If the use of arm and/or leg controls require exertion of forces greater than that for sedentary work and the worker sits most of the time, the job is rated as Light Work.

PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES

Sitting Resting with the body supported by the buttocks or thighs.

Standing Assuming an upright position on the feet particularly for sustained periods of time.

Walking Moving about on foot to accomplish tasks, particularly for long distances.

Climbing Ascending or descending ladders, stairs, scaffolding, ramps, poles, etc. Using feet and legs and/or hands

and arms.

Bending Lowering the body forward from the waist

Stooping Bending body downward and forward by bending spine at the waist through the use of the lower extremities

and back muscles.

Crouching Bending the body downward and forward by bending leg and spine.

Twisting Moving body from the waist using a turning motion. **Reaching** Extending hand(s) and arm(s) in any direction.

Finger Dexterity Picking, pinching, typing or otherwise working primarily with fingers rather than with the whole hand or arm.

Grasping Applying pressure to an object with the fingers and palm.

Talking Expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word. Those activities in which detailed or

important spoken instructions must be conveyed accurately, loudly or quickly.

Visual Acuity The power to see at a level which allows reading of numbers and text, operation of equipment, inspection of

machines, etc.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Indoors / Outdoors The worker is subject to both environmental conditions. Activities occur inside and outside.
