POSITION GOAL

To work with severely communicatively handicapped individuals on designing and utilizing appropriate communication devices, as well as working with teachers and other speech pathologists as a consultant.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES

1. * Serve as one of the local augmentative specialists for Communication Systems Evaluation Center (CSEC) and Seminole County.
2. * Serve as the Seminole County liaison for CSEC.
3. * Oversee and manage CSEC referrals, follow-up process and paperwork.
4. * Coordinate, implement, and serve on the pre and post CSEC evaluation teams with Physical Therapists and Occupational Therapists.
5. * Serve on the Exceptional Student Education Technology Committee.
6. * Prepare and disseminate augmentative information.
7. * Serve as a trainer/educator in the field of augmentation and augmentative communication needs. Provide in-services in those areas.
8. * Consult with teachers of communicatively handicapped students to facilitate more functional communication.
9. * Select and prepare communication boards.
10. * Consult with other speech-language pathologists to facilitate the students' communication needs.
11. * Work with students on a collaborative/consultative model in order to evaluate and provide therapeutic ideas and methods.
12. * Work with CSEC and other community agencies to provide any recommended augmentative devices.
13. * Work with program coordinator to develop augmentative information, tools, and/or other materials.
14. Perform other duties as assigned by the Speech-Language-Hearing Program/Zone Coordinator and/or Director of Exceptional Student Support Services.
