

2024-2025 SCPS Employee Student Transfers

Under the circumstances outlined in School Board Policy 5120 the following SCPS Employee Student transfer options are available:

- Students are allowed to attend the school at which their parent is a full time site based employee.
- Full time status employees who are residents of Seminole County may apply for a district offered employee student transfer to an Under-Capacity school that is specifically designated by the Superintendent for this purpose (see chart below).
- Full time status employees who do not reside in Seminole County may apply for a district offered employee student transfer to an Under-Capacity school that is specifically designated by the Superintendent for this purpose (see chart below).

For the 2024-2025 school year, the Superintendent has identified the following schools as the designated SCPS Employee Student transfer schools:

- SCPS Employee Student transfer requests, if approved, are granted to highest grade of the requested school contingent upon a parent/guardian continuing employment with SCPS and the limitations outlined in School Board Policy 5120.
