

2024-2025 High School Program of Emphasis Transfers

A **Program of Emphasis** provides a structured study strand centered on a career pathway. Students who are zoned for a particular school may select the Program of Emphasis through the course selection process, and a limited number of seats in the designated programs listed below are available for students who are not zoned to the school. Not all Programs of Emphasis have available seats for out of zone students.

For the 2024-2025 school year, the Superintendent has identified the following programs as the designated Program of Emphasis transfer options:

Key Dates:

- February 1, 2024 to March 1, 2024 for on time applications
- July 15, 2024 deadline for late applications
- If more 9th grade applications are received than available 9th grade seats for a program by the on time application deadline, a random selection will be conducted. Applications submitted during the on time application period are of equal weight and not assigned on a first come, first served basis.
- Acceptance into a program of emphasis for out of zone students applying for grade 10 and above is contingent upon a school based administrative review of their transcripts.

Additional Policy Related Information:

- Program of Emphasis transfer requests, if approved, are granted to highest grade of the requested school contingent upon a student being enrolled in and passing the program of emphasis courses each year and the limitations outlined in School Board Policy 5120.
- Once a transfer is approved and a student has enrolled in the transfer school, the student may not re-enroll in the zoned school or transfer to another school until the student has completed the academic year. In each subsequent year, midyear exits are not permitted.
- No transportation is provided by SCPS for approved Program of Emphasis transfer requests.
