- Students zoned for Winter Springs High School Out of zone students on an approved Program of Emphasis transfer
- All students, grades 9-12 can attend

TRANSPORTATION

- Transportation is provided to eligible in-zone students living more than two miles from the school.



This POE is for students who are committed to improving the community through a focus on people and service.
