- In 2018 and 2019, Heathrow Elementary received the highest scores for FSA for Elementary schools in the district.

Student Achievement

2018-2019 Data

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady progress monitoring. **71%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and **76%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **76%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 54%.
