Advanced Placement Test Performance 2019-2020 Data



Hagerty High School administered 1896 Advanced Placement exams in 31 courses (**at no cost** to students). The most popular AP courses are World History, Psychology, English Language and Composition, US History, and US Government and Politics.

HHS had an average **pass rate of 82%** on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

SAT Scores Class of 2019



All juniors and seniors at HHS get an opportunity to take the SAT **at no cost**.

The average Hagerty High School SAT score is **1113** out of 1600, higher than the Florida average of 1069.

PSAT Scores 2019-2020 Data



HHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT **at no cost**.

HHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of **1005** out of 1520, higher than the Florida average of 891.

College Acceleration and Workforce Readiness 2018-2019 Data

72% of HHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

HHS also offers **10 industry certifications**. Some of the most popular ones are Certified Food Protection Manager (ServSafe®) and NIMS Machining Level I - Manual Milling Skills I. In total, students earned **594 industry certifications**.

Hagerty High School had a **97%** graduation rate.

During the 2019-2020 academic year, HHS had over **213 Bright Futures** recipients, totalling over **\$8,327,906** in scholarships.

- HHS has a total enrollment of 2,298 students across grades 9-12.
- Our Program of Emphasis is Modeling, Simulation and Analysis, Science Research, Robotics and Computer Programming.
- In the 2019-2020 school year, 32% of HHS graduates qualified for Bright Futures scholarships.
- We offer 57 different clubs, including many Honor Societies, Pre-Med, Academic Teams, and Modeling and Simulation.
- HHS offers many courses catering to the arts, including award winning theater, band, chorus, dance, art, newspaper and yearbook.
- The athletics program consists of 48 different teams, earning state championships in cheer, basketball, softball, and volleyball.
- HHS offers 31 Advanced Placement (AP) courses with 2080 exams administered in the 2018-2019 school year with a 77.8% pass rate.
