Advanced Placement Test Performance

2018-2019 Data



Hagerty High School administered 2061 Advanced Placement exams in 30 courses (**at no cost** to students). The most popular AP courses are Environmental Science, World History, English Language and Composition, Human Geography, and US History.

HHS had an average **pass rate of 76%** on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

All juniors and seniors at HHS get an opportunity to take the SAT **at no cost**.

The average Hagerty High School SAT score is **1113** out of 1440, higher than the Florida average of 1069.

HHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT **at no cost**.

HHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of **1035** out of 1520, higher than the Florida average of 896.

College Acceleration and Workforce Readiness

71% of HHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

HHS also offers **9 industry certifications**. Some of the most popular ones are Certified Food Protection Manager (ServSafe®) and Adobe Certified Associate (ACA) - Premiere Pro. In total, students earned **594 industry certifications**.

- HHS has a total enrollment of 2,420 students across grades 9-12.
- Our Program of Emphasis is Modeling, Simulation and Analysis, Science Research, Robotics and Computer Programming.
- In 2017-2018, 32% of HHS graduates qualified for Bright Futures scholarships.
- We offer 54 different clubs, including many Honor Societies, Pre-Med, Academic Teams, and Modeling and Simulation.
- HHS offers many courses catering to the arts, including award winning theater, band, chorus, dance, art, newspaper and yearbook.
