### Advanced Placement Test Performance

2019-2020 Data



Lake Howell High School administered 1585 Advanced Placement exams in 31 courses (**at no cost** to students). The most popular AP courses are Human Geography, US History, World History, English Language and Composition, and Statistics.

LHHS had an average **pass rate of 52%** on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

All juniors and seniors at LHHS get an opportunity to take the SAT **at no cost**.

The average Lake Howell High School SAT score is **1005** out of 1600.

LHHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT **at no cost**.

LHHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of **889** out of 1520.

### College Acceleration and Workforce Readiness

**62%** of LHHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

LHHS also offers **8 industry certifications**. Some of the most popular ones are NIMS Machining Level I - Manual Milling Skills I and Certified Food Protection Manager (ServSafe®). In total, students earned **422 industry certifications**.
