Advanced Placement Test Performance

2015-2016 Data



Lake Mary High School administered 2364 Advanced Placement exams in 27 courses during the 2015-16 school year (**at no cost** to students). The most popular AP courses are US History, Human Geography, Environmental Science, Macroeconomics, and World History.

LMHS had an average **pass rate of 53%** on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

SAT Scores

All juniors and seniors at LMHS get an opportunity to take the SAT **at no cost**.

The average Lake Mary High School SAT score is **1531** out of 2400, which puts it in the top 30% of public high schools in Central Florida.

PSAT Scores

LMHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT **at no cost**.

LMHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of **949** out of 1600, which puts it in the top 30% of public high schools in Central Florida.

College Acceleration and Workforce Readiness

49% of LMHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

LMHS also offers **8 industry certifications**. Some of the most popular ones are Photoshop (Creative Cloud 2015 or later), AutoCAD, and Premiere Pro. In total, students earned **231 industry certifications**.

Lake Mary High School had a **92%** graduation rate.

During the 2016-2017 academic year, LMHS had over **270 Bright Futures** recipients, totalling over **\$9,986,007** in scholarships.

State Assessments

Lake Mary High School earned a B grade from the Florida DOE in 2017 and is in the **top 50% of all high schools** statewide.

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- LMHS has a total enrollment of 2,925 students across grades 9-12.
- We offer programs in Forensic Science, Legal Studies, Architectural Drafting, Automation and Production Technology, among many others.
- LMHS is home to a PSI High, a concept where students work in an environment that looks like a high-tech office instead of a classroom.
- LMHS was ranked a top high school by the Washington Post & a Five Star School by the Florida Department of Ed for the 21st consecutive year.
- In 2016, 15% of graduates had a GPA at or above a 4.0 and 143 were recognized as honor graduates.
- We are home to over 40 clubs and 46 athletic teams, and received the All-Sports trophy from the SAC for the fourth straight year!
- LMHS offers 32 AP courses & administered 2,600+ exams, the most in the district. Courses include Statistics, Chem, Comp Science, & English
