Advanced Placement Test Performance 2015-2016 Data



Oviedo High School administered 1736 Advanced Placement exams in 30 courses during the 2015-16 school year (**at no cost** to students). The most popular AP courses are Psychology, Human Geography, English Language and Composition, Macroeconomics, and US Government and Politics.

OHS had an average **pass rate of 66%** on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

SAT Scores 2015-2016 Data



All juniors and seniors at OHS get an opportunity to take the SAT **at no cost**.

The average Oviedo High School SAT score is **1577** out of 2400, which puts it in the top 20% of public high schools in Central Florida.

PSAT Scores 2015-2016 Data



OHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT **at no cost**.

OHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of **974** out of 1600, which puts it in the top 10% of public high schools in Central Florida.

College Acceleration and Workforce Readiness 2015-2016 Data

54% of OHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

OHS also offers **12 industry certifications**. Some of the most popular ones are Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) Bundle Certification (3 of 6), Florida Automobile Dealers Association (FADA) Certified Technician, and Photoshop (Creative Cloud 2015 or later). In total, students earned **335 industry certifications**.



Graduation Success 2015-2016 Data



Oviedo High School had a **90%** graduation rate.

During the 2016-2017 academic year, OHS had over **209 Bright Futures** recipients, totalling over **\$6,944,584** in scholarships.

State Assessments

Oviedo High School earned an A grade from the Florida DOE in 2017 and is in the **top 20% of all high schools** statewide.



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- OHS had a total enrollment of 2,478 students across grades 9-12 in 2016-17.
- OHS offers programs such as Bioscience, Culinary, and Television Production.
- In 2016, 35% of OHS seniors qualified for Bright Futures and earned over \$6.9 million in scholarships
- OHS was ranked a top high school by US News & World Report and the Washington Post.
- OHS offers 29 Advanced Placement (AP) classes and boasts an AP exam pass rate far exceeding state, national and global averages.
- Clubs offered include Beta, SECME, Quill and Scroll, Debate Club, and National Honor Society.
- OHS has numerous athletic teams, including a state champion soccer team, and state runner-up volleyball team.
