### Advanced Placement Test Performance 2020-2021 Data



Oviedo High School administered 1651 Advanced Placement exams in 33 courses (**at no cost** to students). The most popular AP courses are World History, English Language and Composition, Human Geography, Psychology, and Environmental Science.

OHS had an average **pass rate of 66%** on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

### SAT Scores Class of 2020



All juniors and seniors at OHS get an opportunity to take the SAT **at no cost**.

The average Oviedo High School SAT score is **1055** out of 1600, higher than the Florida average of 992.

### PSAT Scores 2020-2021 Data



OHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT **at no cost**.

OHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of **1004** out of 1520, higher than the Florida average of 907.

### College Acceleration and Workforce Readiness 2019-2020 Data

**65%** of OHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

OHS also offers **22 industry certifications**. Some of the most popular ones are Adobe Certified Associate (ACA) - Photoshop (Creative Cloud 2015 or later) and ASE Entry-level - Auto: Brakes (BR). In total, students earned **418 industry certifications**.



### Graduation Success 2020-2021 Data



Oviedo High School had a **99%** graduation rate.

During the 2020-2021 academic year, OHS had over **569 Bright Futures** recipients, totalling over **\$8,180,626** in scholarships.

### State Assessments 2018-2019 Data

Oviedo High School earned an A grade from the Florida DOE in 2019.



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US News and World Report gave OHS a **Silver Medal** among public high schools reviewed on a national basis.

- OHS had a total enrollment of 2,200 students across grades 9-12 in 2020-2021.
- OHS offers CTE programs such as Biotechnology, Culinary Arts, Automotive Repair, Interior Design, Early Childhood Ed, and TV Production.
- In 2020, 28% of OHS seniors qualified for Bright Futures and earned over \$7 million in scholarships.
- OHS was ranked a top high school by US News & World Report and the Washington Post.
- OHS offers 29 Advanced Placement (AP) classes and boasts an AP exam pass rate far exceeding state, national, and global averages.
- Clubs offered include BETA, SECME, Mu Alpha Theta, Quill and Scroll, Debate, National Honor Society, FCA, Robotics, and Best Buddies.
- OHS has numerous athletic teams, including a state champion girls and boys swim team and state champion girls bowling team. For the second year in a row, OHS has been named the FACA Athletic Program of the Year and Floyd E. Lay Sunshine Cup All-Sports Awards Program.
