- Within our MicroSociety, students are prepared to navigate the future workplace, become active citizens, and take on global challenges.
- Through STEAM electives, students are introduced to new technologies and activities designed to build their problem solving and logical thinking.
- Computer Science 2020 Our students participate in at least 10 hours of computer science learning each school year.

#### Student Achievement 2020-2021 Data

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady
  progress monitoring. 56% of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and 55% of K5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **68%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 57%.

- Students are invited to participate in young readers' club which provides an opportunity to foster a love for reading.
- All 4th and 5th grade students receive accelerated learning in the area of math through the SCPS PRIMES program.
- Our award-winning PTA provides our Annual Book Swap to all students, sending books home with students over summer break.
- Students demonstrate positive character traits and are recognized during Character Education celebrations.
- In Project Based Learning activities featured in all grades, students are challenged to solve real-world problems.
