What Makes Us Special

- Wicklow Elementary Magnet School has Dual Language Immersion Program where two classes in each K-5 grade level receive math and science instruction in Spanish taught by a certified Spanish teacher.
- Wicklow Elementary Magnet School for Global Pathways is a Disney Musical School where our scholars will perform Aladdin this year in May! We also have The Orlando Ballet School Program!
- Wicklow has two World Language Labs: Spanish and French. The labs provide support in interpretive and presentational communication where teachers monitor and assist students in the target language.

Student Achievement

2018-2019 Data

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady progress monitoring. **33%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and **47%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **32%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 54%.
