Work Based Learning Experience

October 1st through December 15th

20 hours work experiences are offered in the community at a local business site.

- Flexible scheduling and dates available; WBLEs can be afterschool and on weekends.
- Your Transition Resource Teacher will reach out to you to plan times and location of the worksite.
- This training provides practical exposure to different careers and hands-on training for employability skills at local businesses in Seminole County with a trained job coach. These experiences focus on practicing social skills and building relationships.
- Students must provide their own transportation to and from the worksite.
