What Makes Us Special

- Red Bug earned the state of Florida Positive Behavior Intervention Support Gold Model School Status designation in 2021 through the use of school-wide common language and incentive system.
- Students have the opportunity to participate in the Dual Language program in which classes are taught in both English and Spanish languages. Students also learn about Hispanic countries and culture.
- Through weekly class meetings, integrated learning, and differentiated instruction, our highly qualified teachers and staff meet the varying needs of our students academics and social-emotional needs.

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady progress monitoring. **75%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and **72%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **58%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 57%.
